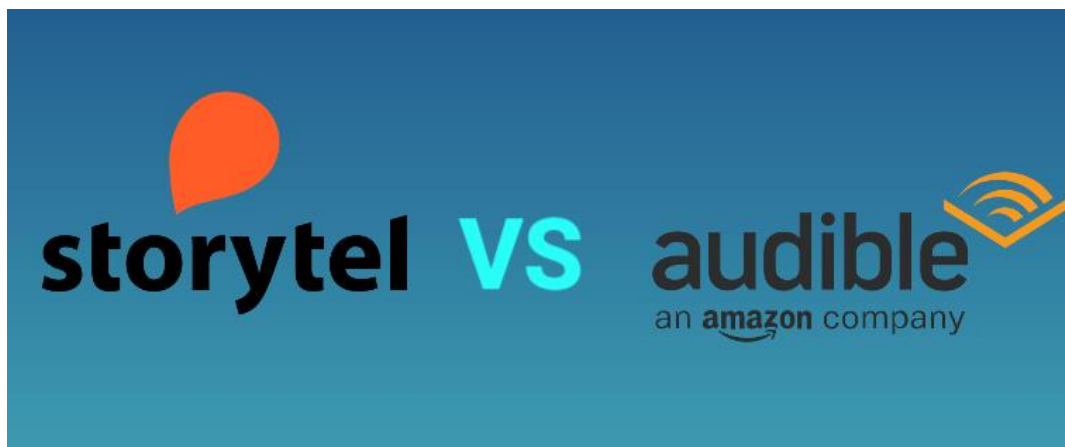




Storytel VS Audible: Which is Better?



Storytel vs. Audible: What's the best audiobook service? These two are, undoubtedly, the best ones out there. They have the largest catalogs of audiobooks in the English-speaking and non English-speaking market, and each has irresistible perks. But there are some key differences between the two. With Audible, you get a huge library of audiobooks, from the obscure and the best-selling to classics and best sellers titles. You name it, and Audible may have it. Storytel audiobooks are a great alternative. It offers “unlimited” audiobooks — we’ll explore later on what that entails. Is Audible better than Storytel? In this guide, I review Storytel and Audible, outlining their pros and cons to answer the question of which is better and help you decide the one that’s right for you.

Part 1. Brief Introduction to Storytel and Audible

What is Audible?

Audible is a prominent audiobook and spoken-word entertainment service owned by Amazon. It offers a vast collection of audiobooks, podcasts, and exclusive content. Users can purchase and own audiobooks individually or subscribe to a monthly credit-based system, which allows them to access premium titles. Audible is available globally and is known for its extensive library, including bestsellers and exclusive productions.

What is Storytel?

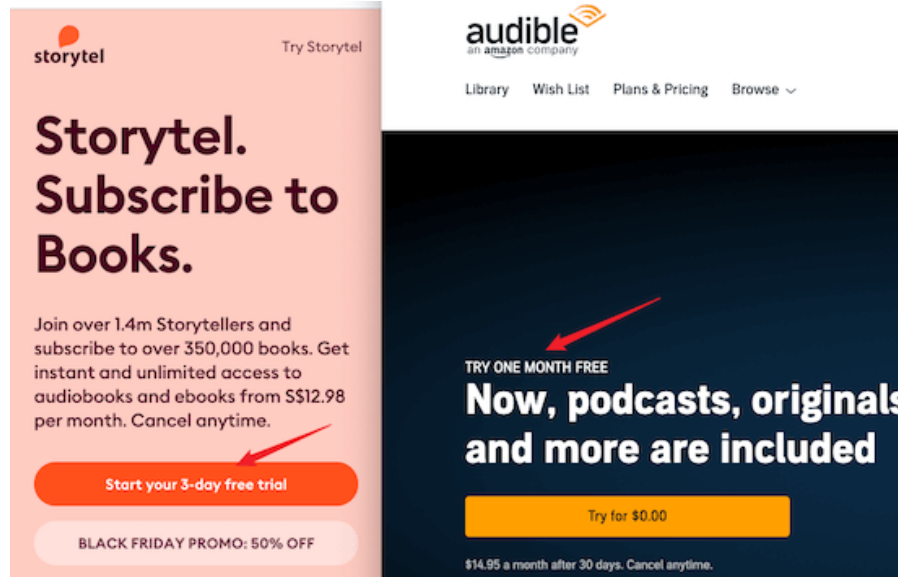
Storytel is a global audiobook and ebook streaming service that operates on a subscription-based model. It provides users with unlimited access to a diverse library of audiobooks and ebooks. Storytel aims to offer a rich storytelling experience, combining both audio and text formats. The service varies in terms of available content across different regions, and it is recognized for its user-friendly platform and the convenience of all-inclusive subscriptions.

Editor's Note: If you're looking to read ebooks, Storytel is the preferable option, as Audible does not include ebooks in its library.

Part 2. Storytel vs Audible: Free Trial

Both Audible and Storytel typically offer a free trial period for new users to explore their service before committing to a subscription. You can choose to use either of their subscription plans during the trial period. However, the Audible trial has a time limit of 30 days, while the Storytel trial time limit varies in different countries. For example, if you choose Singapore, the trial period is 3 days, but it

is 15 days in France. After checking the Storytel trial limits, we found that the longest trial period is 15 days. Therefore, for the free trial, Audible offers a longer period than Storytel.



Editor's Note: For an extended trial period, opt for Audible. Given that both services provide a free trial, consider trying both to personally experience and discern their differences.

Part 3. Storytel vs Audible: Price & Plans

Storytel and Audible both offers the subscription service, but the price and the subscription model is different.

Editor's Note: The pricing for both services is nearly identical. Let's compare Audible Premium Plus to Storytel Unlimited+. Their benefits differ in two key ways. If I were making the choice, I would lean towards Audible. Why? Audible supports Household, allowing more than two adults and two children to access the household library. Furthermore, with Audible, you receive one credit to purchase an audiobook, and you get to keep it even if you cancel the subscription. On the other hand, with Storytel, for a similar price, you can only add two accounts to access the Storytel library, and there are no benefits retained when you cancel the subscription.

Part 4. Storytel vs Audible: Titles & Library

As the biggest audiobook producer and provider, there are over 550,000 audiobooks available on Audible. Plus Catalog contains thousands of audiobooks, podcasts, and Audible Originals that you can stream or download to listen to offline. They add new titles to the catalog weekly. It currently contains 11,000+ titles in Audible plus Catalog. Find the most popular Audible plus audiobooks here: [Audible plus catalog link\(The most popular ones\)](#).

Storytel stands as one of the globe's premier subscribed audiobook and e-book streaming services, providing access to over 400,000 titles for both listening and reading on a worldwide scale. Do this mean you can listen or read all these Storytel titles? The answer is definitely "No". Due to the region limits, some of the titles may be restricted by copyright on your region. So we cannot tell how many titles you can access during your subscription period. Actually, a lot of people have complained about the limits of storytel library.

Editor's Note: It is widely acknowledged that Audible has the largest library of audiobooks in the world.

Part 5. Storytel vs Audible: Category

Audible is exclusively an audiobook streaming service. It offers a vast library of audiobooks, podcasts, and exclusive content. Users can purchase and own audiobooks individually or subscribe for a monthly credit-based system.

Storytel offers both ebooks and audiobooks at a monthly subscription fee. It provides a subscription-based model for unlimited access to both audiobooks and ebooks. Their library may vary by region.

Editor's Note: Audible is exclusively for audiobooks, whereas Storytel offers both ebooks and audiobooks.

Part 6. Audible vs Storytel: Integration

Audible is owned by Amazon. You can access Audible books via the Audible subscription service or Amazon Prime. However, Audible and Amazon Prime have separate subscriptions. You have to pay separately for Audible or the Audible Prime service. With Amazon Prime, you can enjoy Prime Reading, which includes books with Audible Narration. Prime members can also access Audible books without an Audible subscription. However, the Amazon Prime Audible catalog is not as large as Audible Plus.

Storytel operates independently, and its subscription is not integrated with other services like Amazon Prime.

Editor's Note: There are multiple ways to access Audible audiobooks: through the Audible subscription service, Amazon Prime, or by purchasing them directly with credits or money. In contrast, Storytel audiobooks and ebooks can only be accessed through a Storytel subscription.

Part 7. Audible vs Storytel: Region Limits

Audible is widely available globally, with a broad selection of languages and titles. Doesn't like the Storytel which is operate all countries at one site, Audible has a number of website that target a different customer population defined by language preference or location. It is important to learn that your Audible marketplace is determined by the country you live in. [Learn the Audible market place supported countries or regions.](#)

Storytel is available in multiple countries, and the library may vary depending on the region. Please note your storytel account is linked to the country where you are or that your phone (google or apple account) is linked to (regardless of the language your phone or the app is set to). This has to do with copyright reasons, as Storytel has specific rights for books depending on the user's country of residence. If you need to read the ebooks or audiobooks in some language not listed in your country, you may need to create a new account on the target country.

Part 8. Audible vs Storytel: Device limits & How to Break Device Limits

Audible device limit & How to break it

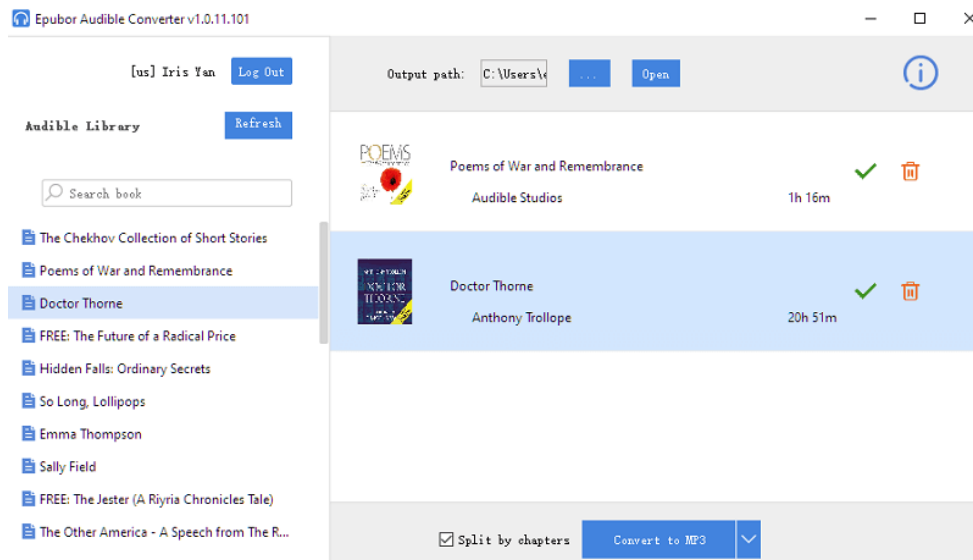
Audible offers the Audible app for Android, iOS, and online platforms, providing users with the flexibility to listen to audiobooks. However, if you've purchased an audiobook with credits, you can also download it to your PC/Mac. Please note that your Audible books are linked to your Audible account. To listen to Audible, you need to authorize compatible devices or apps first. **You are restricted to Audible-compatible apps and devices, correct?**

If you did not purchase your Audible books with credits or money, you can only listen to them. The "Download" button will not be available. **You may not be able to download the Audible books in your Audible library, correct?**

Is there any way to fix these two issues? The [Epubor Audible Converter](#) is highly recommended here. It can help you convert your downloaded Audible

books to MP3, MP4, or M4B format with 100% original quality. Moreover, if you sign in Audible in Epubor Audible Converter, you'll be able to load your whole Audible library and can even download all Audible audiobooks to M4B/MP3. (Please note: Audible podcasts aren't supported, only Audible audiobooks.).

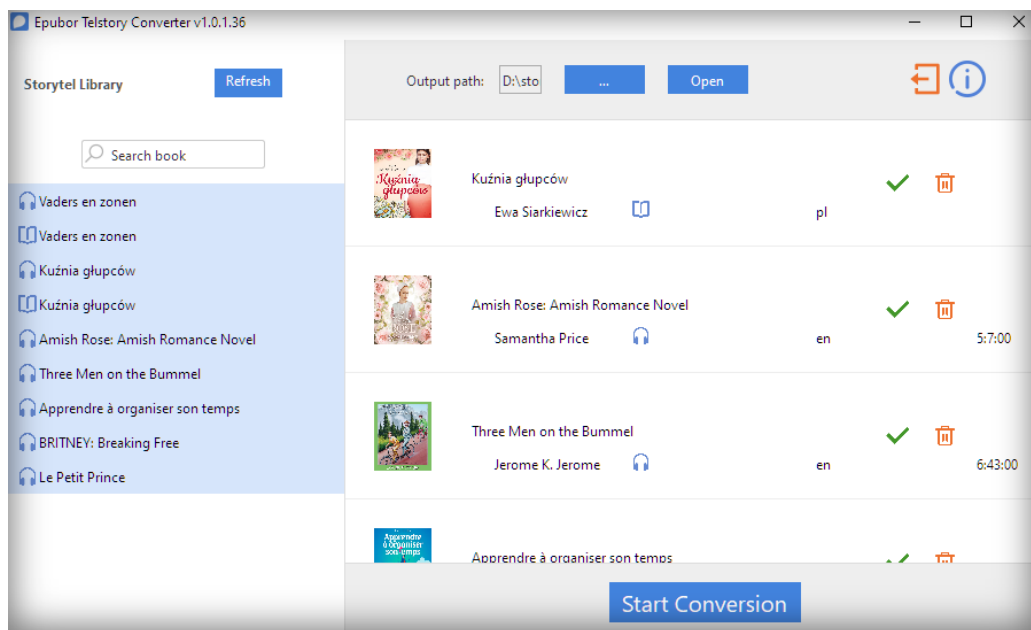


Storytel device limit & how to break it

Storytel is a slightly different from Audible. Storytel does not offer the download button on Windows and Mac computer. It only allows you to download Storytel audiobooks and ebooks on Android or iOS devices. However, the download Storytel are not in the common format which can not be recognized by the popular devices or apps.

Is there anyway to break the Storytel device limits? Yes, with [Epubor Telstory Converter](#), you can easily download Telstory audiobooks to MP3 and ebooks to epub format.
